1.No person shall start or have any open fire without first obtaining a permit.  An open fire is described as any fire upon any woodlands, grasslands, field, or public right-of-way in the Township of Montrose not wholly contained within an incinerator, outdoor fireplace, grill or other receptacle constructed for, and suitable to the purpose of the burning. A campfire of a reasonable size (no bonfire) is permissible on private property. They must be contained in a fire ring or other rated container and be attended by a person of mature age.  2.No person shall start or have any open fire whenever there is a dauger of the fire spreading outside the control of the person attending/responsible.  Danger of spreading pertains to, but is not limited to such things as, high winds, dry conditions, burning bans and drought. If weather conditions are favorable for the fire spreading outside of the control of the person attending/responsible the burn is not permitted.  3.No person shall have or start an open fire and leave the fire unattended until the fire has been completely extinguished.  Open fires must be attended at all times by at least one of the names listed above.  4.No fire (open burn or campfire) shall produce a nuisance or hazard.  If the police or fire department, or township representative deem the fire, smoke, ash, or odor to be a nuisance or hazard to surrounding residents, property and/or general traffic, the fire must be extinguished.  5. You shall NOT burn any construction material, any household trash, any toxic and/or chemical materials, such as tires, paint, plastics, or any materials brought from off site.  ANY PERSON VIOLATING THE ABOVE PROVISIONS MAY BE CHARGED WITH A MISDEMEANOR		
PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$100 AND/OR BY IMPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COURT. PERSONS MAY ALSO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR COSTS INCURRED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MONTROSE.
