

City of Montrose and Montrose Township Residential Scrap Tire Clean-up Program Information

MONDAY, MAY 22, 2017

Annual Scrap Tire Pickup Day - **Monday, May 22, 2017**

Residents will be allowed to place up to ten (10) passenger tires along their road frontage and or curb where the tires can be picked up and recycled through First Class Tire Shredders.

If a resident has more than ten (10) passenger tires in need of disposal, they must contact the Montrose Township Building Department and arrange for an inspection of the tires prior to placement at the curb. This inspection is needed to provide advance notice to the licensed hauler about the increase in the amount of tires to be picked up at a single location and the inspection must be completed at least one week prior to the scheduled annual pick-up day.

Scrap Tire Drop-off Dates & Fees

Annual Scrap Tire Pick-up Day – Monday, May 22, 2017, Residents are to place scrap tires at roadside by 8 a.m. – **Free to Township Residents.**

Daily Tire Drop-off Days – Weekly, Monday through Thursday, between the hours of 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. – **Free with Scrap Tire Permit from Montrose Township Clerk's Office.**
