

Montrose Township Senior Center

Re-Opening Plan

Pre-Opening—Conduct a thorough cleaning and sanitizing of the entire building especially focusing on the kitchen area. Taping 6-foot markers on the floor in high traffic areas as well as in the main activity room to ensure participants are staying 6 feet apart and abiding by the social distancing rules currently in place. We will only be allowing 25% of our maximum capacity into the building at one time (including staff), so the maximum number of seniors allowed in the building will be 15. Hand sanitizer stations will be placed in several locations around the building. We will also have disinfecting solution and rags available for seniors to use.

Entrance/Exit—The front doors will be the only entry point into the building. Upon entrance there will be a table set up for staff to screen seniors, take temperatures, and ensure they have the proper PPE needed to enter into the building. The back door will be the only exit in order to ensure proper social distancing and control traffic. There will also be 6-foot markers on taped onto the floor in both entry and exit points.

Refreshments—All coffee, water pitchers, and snacks will be kept in the kitchen and served to the seniors from the kitchen window.

Lunch—Lunch will be limited to 12 participants in the center at one time. Multiple sessions of lunch may be needed. We will also still offer take-out lunches for those who do not feel comfortable coming inside.

Computer Room/Library—This room will be limited to one person at a time. We will start taking appointments to use the computer to ensure social distancing and make sure everyone who needs to use the computer get a chance.

Bus—Transportation will be limited to two riders at a time. With the size of our bus we can have one person in the back and one in the front and still comply with social distancing. All riders will be screened, temperature taken, and required to wear a mask.

MMAV, Veterans, and Legal Services—These services will resume as soon as the partnering agency allows following social distancing guidelines.
